MAATAURANGA (CULTURE AND ARTS) GRANTS

PURPOSE

The purpose of this grant is to support events and activities promoting Maori culture, arts and crafts including kapa haka, manu korero, tikanga wananga, waiata as well as participation in the arts and crafts generally including weaving, textiles, fashion, carving, music, drama, poetry, dance, painting, pottery, sculpture, glass works, applied arts & design within the Hauraki rohe, by encouraging the participation of Pare Hauraki individuals and or groups in national or international forums and to acknowledge these achievements and excellence in cultural and artistic pursuits.

Maatauranga (Culture & Arts) Grants will be considered all year round.

The following criteria shall apply in the management and funding of Maatauranga (Culture and Arts) Grants:

- Grants shall be provided throughout the year provided that applications are made 12 weeks prior to the event or project deadline.
- You may only make one application per financial year.
- Priority will be given to events, initiatives and activities which are being held within the Hauraki rohe and or have a Hauraki focus-kaupapa.
- To be eligible to apply you must whakapapa to one or more of the Hauraki iwi and be registered with the Hauraki Maori Trust Board.
- Applicants must also represent Hauraki at regional, national or international forums.
- Where an application is made on behalf of a group/trust/organisation, at least a significant majority of the persons benefiting from the grant must be registered with the Hauraki Maori Trust Board for the total grant to be applied. Where less than one half of its members whakapapa to one or more of the Hauraki iwi, then only a portion of the total grant will be available.
- The grant does not cover the purchase of fixed assets or capital items, wages, salaries or business ventures.
- A photo of the applicant(s) must be provided with the application.
- The Hauraki Maori Trust Board reserves the right to use your names, photo and other details for publicity and promotional purposes.
- The Hauraki Maori Trust Board has the sole discretion to accept or decline an application that does not meet the criteria. Its decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
- A report of the event or purpose for which the grant was given is to be provided to the Board within 8 weeks after the event has occurred. If this is not provided, you may not be eligible for future grants.
